OVER-THE-TOP CONIFER TIP

SureGuard EZ may be applied over-the-top to many dormant (hardened off) conifer plants. As a rule, never apply before 2 hard freezes and never after spring bud break

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Pre-emerge herbicide rotation is an important resistant management tool. SureGuard EZ is a group 14 herbicide, rotate with, or tank mix with, other pre-emerge group herbicides.

GAIN FLEXIBILITY: A WIDER APPLICATION WINDOW

SureGuard® EZ offers a significant advantage over the competition, it controls pre-emerge weeds as well as emerged weeds up to 2" high. When application timing is running a little behind, rest assured that both pre- and post-emerge weeds are captured with SureGuard EZ.



PRE-EMERGE CONTROL

Make application to the soil surface prior to weed emerge. Do not apply to the foliage, green stems or exposed roots of desirable plants. Moisture is needed to move SureGuard EZ into the soil. Dry weather following application may reduce effectiveness. However, when adequate moisture is received after dry conditions, susceptible germinating weeds will be controlled.



POST-EMERGE CONTROL

For best results, apply to actively growing weeds less than 2" in height. For most effective post-emerge weed control, apply with a surfactant under sunny conditions at temperatures above 65°F. SureGuard EZ is rainfast in 1 hour, do not apply if rain is expected within 1 hour.

GAIN OPTIONS: ONE PRODUCT FOR MANY USES

SureGuard EZ is labeled for use on many sites. Take care of landscape beds, cracks and crevices, bare ground areas, dormant Bermudagrass, aquatic sites and more.



ESTABLISHED WOODY LANDSCAPE ORNAMENTALS

Apply as directed sprays around well-established woody shrubs and trees. Do not apply around landscape ornamentals for at least 30 days after transplant, or at least 2 months before ornamentals will be planted.



BARE GROUND NON-CROP AREAS

Use for non-selective vegetation control to maintain bare ground non-crop areas. Do not apply when weather conditions favor spray drift from treated areas.



TURF AND ORNAMENTAL SITES

Keep areas in and around woody shrubs, deciduous trees, and conifers weed free with broad-spectrum pre- and early post-emerge control. Do not apply to stressed plants.



CONTAINER- AND FIELD-GROWN DECIDUOUS TREES AND CONIFERS

Apply as single or split applications to established trees. Do not apply to trees or transplants less than 1 year. May apply over the top only if bud break has not occurred or plants are hardened off.



AQUATIC WEED CONTROL

Control floating or emerged weeds using surface applications or floating and submersed weeds using subsurface applications. For most effective control, apply to actively growing weeds in water with a pH of less than 8.5.

WARM-SEASON TURF TIP



SPLIT

Apply as single or split applications to well established dormant Bermudagrass to control annual bluegrass, winter annuals. Apply late winter to dormant Bermudagrass for summer annuals including goosegrass and crabgrass.
